IFA Kim Gai Soh Memorial Golf Tournament

Kings' Island Golf Club – Monday, 8 November 2010

In conjunction with the IFA Crossroads Asia-Pacific 2010 Conference, the 7th IFA Kim Gai Soh Memorial Golf Tournament will be held at the Kings' Island Golf Club on Monday, 8 November 2010.

Kings' Island Golf Club is located near Son Tay, Ha Tay Province, Viet Nam, 36 km West of Hanoi via the highway from Lang Ha to Hoa Lac, and 45 km from Noi Bai International Airport. Kings' Island has 2 courses – Lakeside and Mountainview.

The tournament will be held at the Lakeside Course, Par 72, 6,454 yards. The Lakeside Course is designed by Robert McFarland, an American Golf Course Architect. He has designed championship golf courses around the world, including Mission Hills in California. He specializes in challenging designs using natural terrain and hazards. At Kings' Island this includes many and varied uses of water surrounding the course and gently sloping terrain, with small greens and ample fairways.

The Kings' Island has a new Clubhouse with Swimming Pool, Sauna, Jacuzzi, air-conditioned Restaurant, fully air-conditioned changing rooms with 600 lockers, and a fully equipped Pro-Shop and Driving Range.

This tournament will be limited to 18 flights (72 players) in order to have a shotgun start. Details of the tournament rules and a flight reservation form are attached.

Reserve-a-flight: IFA member companies participating in the conference are invited to reserve one or more flights on a first-come, first-served basis up to 6 October 2010. Each flight will have up to four players of their choice and the flight fee is 750 Euros (inclusive of 10% VAT).

The IFA Secretariat must receive all names by October 11, 2010. Substitution will be allowed up to October 30, 2010.

The Kim Gai Soh Memorial Trophy will be awarded for the Best Gross and the IFA Challenge Trophy will be awarded for Individual Stableford Points based on full handicap. These trophies will be reserved exclusively for IFA members. There will also be other prizes awarded for individual play.

Please register early, using the flight reservation form given as Appendix 1, in order to assist the Golf Organizing Committee with their arrangements.

TOURNAMENT RULES

IFA Kim Gai Soh Memorial Golf Tournament

A. RULES OF PLAY

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrew's and the United States Golf Association (USGA), and where applicable, by the local rules of the Kings' Island Golf Club.

B. PLAY FORMAT

- 1) The tournament will be played as an eighteen (18) hole Gross Stroke Play and Stableford Points event based on full handicap, with a shotgun start.
- 2) All players should putt out however, "gimme" putts within 18 inches (putter length) from the hole will be allowed to speed up play. Changing of balls on the green is not allowed.

3) HANDICAPS

Participants are requested to submit their certified "Home" Club handicap (maximum allowable for the tournament is 24 for men and 36 for ladies), with their entry. Players with handicaps beyond 24 may still join, subject to the Organizing Committee's approval, but shall use a 24 handicap. If a participant has more than one handicap, the lowest handicap shall apply.

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE IFA TOURNAMENT TROPHY, PLEASE BRING YOUR HANDICAP CARD TO THE TOURNAMENT, which will be verified during registration.

4) TIES

Ties for the Best Gross scores will be broken by first, a countback of the back nine total score, if still tied, by a countback of the front nine total score and if still tied, by countback of scores on individual holes, commencing with hole # 18, 17, 16 etc.

Ties for the Stableford Points will be broken by first, a countback of the back nine total points. If still tied, by countback of the front nine total points. If still tied, by points scored on individual holes, commencing with hole # 18, 17, 16 etc. If the scores are still tied, the Co-Chairmen will decide.

5) RECORDING OF SCORES

All players must exchange scorecards with their playing partner and record the gross score on each hole, for both the player and the marker. It is the responsibility of each player to check their hole-by-hole scores for accuracy. Only score cards verified and signed by the player and the marker will qualify for the tournament prizes. Score cards are to be given to the designated official scorers immediately after the game.

6) WINNERS/PRIZES

- 1) The Kim Gai Soh Memorial Trophy will be awarded for the Best Gross score and the IFA Challenge Trophy will be awarded for the Individual Stableford Points scored based on full handicap. These Trophies will be reserved exclusively for IFA member company representatives.
- 2) Prizes for individual play will also be awarded.
- 3) Except for the Kim Gai Soh Memorial Trophy and the IFA Challenge Trophy, trophies and corresponding prizes are open to all participants.
- 4) Participants shall be eligible for only one (1) trophy/prize.

7) FLIGHT FEE / DEADLINE

- 1) A flight fee (up to four players) of 750 Euros (inclusive of 10% VAT) will be charged to cover the green fees, insurance, mandatory golf cart (2 persons per golf cart), caddies, cooler box, lunch with drinks, prizes, gifts and transport to and from the InterContinental Hotel, Hanoi.

Transportation will leave the InterContinental Hotel at 6.00 hours on Monday, 8 October 2010. Players are invited to gather at 5.45 hours.

Tee-off will be at 8.00 hours. **Participants are requested to be at the Kings' Island Golf Club for the tournament briefing not later than 7.45 hours.**

Lunch will be served at the Club after the tournament.

Transportation will leave from the Kings' Island Golf Club at 15.00 hours.

9) GOLF SHOES AND CLUBS

Wilson Golf clubs and shoes are available for rental. The Wilson Golf Clubs rental is US\$ 30.00 net per set.

No metal spiked shoes are allowed on the golf course. Please wear soft spiked shoes.

10) BAD WEATHER

In the event the Golf Tournament is interrupted due to inclement weather, the Golf Organizing Committee will deliberate and decide on the results of the Golf Tournament.

11) DECISIONS

The decisions of the Golf Organizing Committee are final.
